## Temporary Road Closures

**Clyde Bridge – Matau St – Clyde**  
 Clyde Bridge (Matau Street) will be closed between 20 -24 May 2024 for bridge repair works.  
 A detour for vehicles will be in place via Fruitgrowers Road - Clyde Dam Bridge - and Sunderland Street.  
 Cyclists will have access across Clyde Bridge but may have to dismount. Traffic crew will be at the bridge 24 hours to assist.



**Kerry Court - Cromwell**  
 Kerry Court in Cromwell will be closed between Antrim Street and the cul de sac, on 3 May 2024 to repair a water leak.  
 Residents will have access to their properties at all times with traffic crew to assist on site.

**Butcher Drive - Cromwell**  
 The northern end (by Melmore Terrace) of Butcher Drive in Cromwell will be closed 14 May to 15 August 2024 for tree felling and demolition works.  
 Access to the Cromwell Town and Country Club and Butcher Drive will still be available via Barry Avenue.
