Neplusultra Street Reserve management plan

The public will be asked to give feedback on two amendments to the reserve management plan for Neplusultra Street Reserve, Cromwell. The proposed changes will make it possible for Council to establish a public toilet on the reserve, and to reduce existing grassed beautification strips from 30 metres to 15 metres on street frontages.

Public consultation will be open from 9 April to 9 May, with proposed changes considered by Cromwell Community Board and recommended to Council for approval on 21 May.
