From 20 January 2025



Use Water Wisely

- Water demand is HIGH
- Only water between 6pm and 8am
- Only water when garden needs it
- Avoid watering paths and driveways
- Fix any leaks.



Reduce Water Use

- Water demand is EXCESSIVE and/or source water is LOW
- Only water between 8pm and 8am for no more than 30 mins per spot
- Reduce water use NOW to avoid further restrictions.



Water Restrictions Apply

- The community is using more water than our plant can produce and/or more water than our source can supply
- TOTAL sprinkler ban
- Irrigation by hand-held hose only.
