## Tree Felling at Cromwell BMX Park

Tree felling will take place at Cromwell BMX Park from 14 April to 18 April. During this period, some sections of the bike park will be temporarily closed, and traffic management will be implemented on Neplusultra Street.

The work will involve the removal of large trees along the Neplusultra side of the park. These trees pose a safety risk in strong winds and they are causing surface damage to the Learn to Ride area due to their roots.
