Bore testing at Bullock Track, Roxburgh

Investigation for test bore drilling at Bullock Track near Roxburgh is getting underway this week.

This is taking place on the accessway between Fairview Orchard and Teviot Orchard.

During the work, access to the track may be restricted to walking only, with the assistance of a site crew member to navigate around the working plant and machinery.

The work is expected to take two to three weeks and will include drilling the new bore and testing for flow and quality.

This investigation is part of identifying a suitable alternative water source for the Roxburgh and Lake Roxburgh Village drinking water town supply.



Centrepoint carpark tree works

Four trees are to receive maintenance in the Centrepoint carpark in Alexandra with the work is to be carried out jointly by Limerick Properties Limited and the Council.

The carpark contains a number of mature Claret Ash trees, some on Limerick Properties land and some on Council land – on the state highway and Ennis Street corner, which are now too close to the adjacent building.

During the tree work, part of the car park will be closed, along with the access to Ennis Street.

An additional Claret Ash tree may also be removed from the Tarbert Street side to enable Council's roading contractors to reseal the carpark and remove root hazards. A new tree pit will be constructed for a smaller shade tree to be planted.

Drinking Water Public Notice

Some plumbing fittings have the potential to allow minute traces of metals to accumulate in water standing in fittings for several hours.

Although the health risk is small, the Ministry of Health recommends that you flush a cupful of water from your drinking-water tap each morning, before use, to remove any metals that may have dissolved from plumbing fittings.

This simple precaution is recommended by the Ministry of Health for all households, including those on public and private water supplies.
