Bridge Closure – Bridge 160 Linnburn Runs Road

Background:

During a bridge inspection 2021, it was determined there were significant structural issues affecting the load carrying elements of Bridge 160 Linnburn Runs Rd (Blackball). The bridge was immediately closed by the engineers at the time of the inspection (27/01/2021) to ensure public safety.

Despite the closure (via a locked gate), it was brought to Council's attention that vehicles have continued to gain access. The decision has therefore been made to remove the gate and formally close the bridge to mitigate the risk of an incident. Signage has been installed on each approach, and fencing erected at either end of the bridge.

Regarding the closure:

- There is no through traffic via Linnburn Runs Road, due to the closure of Bridge 160 over the Taieri River. The road is accessible either side of the bridge for property access.
- The alternative route/river crossing is via Loganburn Ford Road.

The alternative route is sign-posted at the intersections of:

- Linnburn Runs Rd/Upper Taieri-Paerau Rd
- Linnburn Runs Rd Junction
- Linnburn Runs Rd/ Upper Taieri-Paerau Rd
- Upper Taieri-Paerau Rd/Loganburn Ford Rd

Reminder

Rabbit control is getting underway from next Tuesday (30 July 2024) weather dependent, and the operation will take place over the next six weeks at Cromwell Cemetery, Clyde Cemetery and Half Mile Recreation Reserve and the block the corner block on the corner of the Clyde-Alexandra Road and Mutton Town Road.

Council, under the Otago Regional Council Pest Plan like all landowners, is required to carry out rabbit control on its own land.

Please keep dogs out of these areas while the operation is underway.

Where possible rabbit carcasses will be regularly collected.
