Resource Management Act 1991

Public Notice of the Operative Date of a Plan Change to the Central Otago District Plan.

Pursuant to Clause 20(1) of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991 the Central Otago District Council gives public notice of the date upon which Plan Change 22 will become operative. Plan Change 22 Light (Dark Sky) proposed to amend the operative Central Otago District Plan to include a new section in the Plan that supports the protection, maintenance and enhancement of the night sky from the adverse effects of lighting. The new section will be Section 20 of the operative Central Otago District Plan.

The new section applies to mapped areas identified in the District Plan as being subject to a "Dark Sky Precinct" notation. The Plan Change creates the first precinct in Naseby.

Council notified its decision on 11 July 2024. The period for appeals on the decision closed on 22 August 2024. No appeals were received.

The Central Otago District Council gives notice that Plan Change 22 will become operative on Friday 4 October 2024.

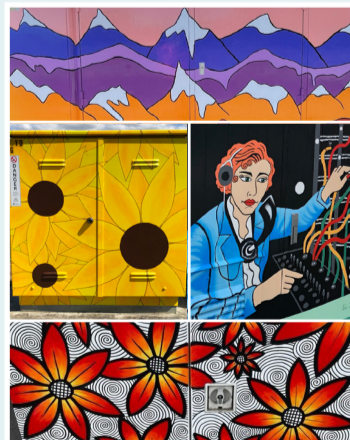
