### Alexandra Blossom Festival - Mardi Gras and Motocross Event

Council proposes to close a section of Rivers Street, Alexandra, between Thompson Street and 32 Rivers Street, 1pm-9pm, Friday 27 September 2024.

State Highway/Centennial Avenue and Tarbert Street will also be closed between Clutha and Bantry streets, and Killarney Street will be closed between Brandon Street and Centennial Avenue. Time of proposed closures will be 10am-3pm, Saturday 28 September 2024.
