SUPPORT FOR .A FURTHER SUBMISSION BY WOOING TREE VINEYARD PLUBLICLY NOTIFIED PLAN CHANGE 12 TO CENTRAL OTAGO DISTRICT PLAN

This is a further submission in **SUPPORT** of the proposed Plan Change 12 to the Central Otago District Plan.

Key Points:

BACKGROUND: Central Otago has gained an international reputation for the quality of its wine. The result is a higher number of 'sophisticated spending visitors' (refer attached STUFF article) visiting the region to learn more about our wine and food. Tourism projections show this demand will increase significantly over the next decade. Many are independent travellers (not coach tours).

Cromwell needs to support this tourist activity – currently it is not. A **boutique hotel with retail** aimed at visitors is desperately needed. The Proposed Plan change will help support these visitors to stay longer, providing opportunities for the community at large.

1.0 VINEYARD PLANTING/GREEN SPACES: These are essential. I would not be in support of the proposal if these were not there. Currently Wooing Tree provides a very important visual statement to any visitor arriving in Cromwell – they know they are in the heart of our wine industry. It is estimated that 70% of all grape production for the whole of the Central Otago region is located in the Cromwell Basin (which is Bannockburn in the south, Cromwell/Lowburn, Pisa and Queensbury sub-regions on the western side of Lake Dunstan and Tarras, Bendigo bordering the lake to the East).

The proposed Plan clearly indicates vines will remain in place and border the development - in addition **GREEN SPACES** between residential sites has also been included. Suggestions that this proposed development will devalue current residents properties in my view is a misunderstanding the proposal – one only has to look at property values in Arrowtown and Queenstown to see quite the opposite is likely to happen. Property values have increased significantly in both those towns.

- 2.0 ACCOMMODATION/RETAIL BOUTIQUE HOTEL: In my view there is one major problem to the growth of Cromwell as a place to stop and spend time in and that is the a lack of good 4.5 star accommodation/with a restaurant for the growing number of international independent travellers interested in visiting the regions vineyards. A boutique hotel of 50-60 rooms could only benefit the town. Another problem that visitors have with Cromwell is they find it difficult to spend any money. There is NO retail to support them. There are of course shops in Wanaka/Arrowtown Queenstown providing high end quality goods that tourists want to buy but not in Cromwell.
- **3.0 HOUSING**: Concerns expressed in the Otago Daily Times about the areas rural residential appeal being lost, are, in my opinion misjudging the proposal. I would think the last thing any developer putting in a 4.5 star boutique hotel accommodation (or Wooing Tree Vineyard with their own business for that matter) would want is high-density low cost housing right next to boutique accommodation, or a winery offering tastings to visitors it just doesn't make sound business sense.

SUMMARY:

The Wooing Tree Vineyard's location is very important to our wine industry. I regard it as an asset to Cromwell. I urge Council to support this Plan change so that a combination of boutique accommodation, winery, and residential development can take place – creating opportunities for all of us in the community.



There is even a smartphone app called Campable connecting motorhome tourists with places to stay, including some vineyards.

Australia, followed by the US, UK and Germany, and most of them are independent travellers.

They tend to be more interested in art and cultural tourism activities rather than adventure activities.

About 24 per cent of Scandinavian visitors described themselves as wine tourists in a recent survey, followed by similar percentages from Finland, Canada, Denmark, England, and the US.



Naish said Americans seemed especially keen on the cellar door experience where they can enjoy tastings and discuss the qualities of wine.

"We work with a few high end tour guides who bring out smaller parties of tourists for an afternoon of wining and dining. We don't have capacity for very large groups."

Winery tourists stay longer and spend more, estimated on average to be

\$3/00 compared with the \$2000 average spend of all visitors.

A 2014 survey showed Marlborough had the highest number of international tourists visiting wineries (43,000), followed by Auckland (30,000) and Hawkes Bay (24,800), and smaller numbers visiting wineries in Queenstown, Nelson, Wairarapa, Canterbury and Central Otago 4100. NZ Wine marketing director Chris Yorke said strong TripAdvisor ratings showed how popular the wine tours were, although the biggest thing that turns tourists off is the occasional experience of being charged for wine tasting.

The association's new web pages showcase more than 230 cellar door offerings, 110 winery dining options, 60 vineyard accommodation outlets, and 50 onsite tours.

NZ Wine is also partnering with Tourism New Zealand to develop online tourism training modules for wineries.

Another source of information for wineries and visitors is the wine tourism network web site operated by New Zealand Travel Infocus.

The age groups that feature most are between 25 to 34 (26 per cent), with a drop off during the years people typically raise families, before the next second strongest age group of 55-64 (23 per cent).

The most common accommodation used by wine visitors are hotels and motels followed by privately home stays, holiday parks, and a backpackers.
