The proposed development by River Terraces Development Limited is in the wrong location being too close to existing business' e.g. orchards, stock car track, Highlands Motor Sport Park etc.

As a member of Highlands I am aware of the tremendous economic benefits it has brought to the area as an event centre / museum and tourist attraction.

I am also aware of the complaints by a few people inhibiting the park reaching its full potential.

The proposed River Terraces development is too close and too intensive essentially setting up a small town in competition to Cromwell.

Some residents will undoubtedly complain about noise from orchards / vineyards and stock car events plus Highlands activities. viz. Paul Keast in Alexandra – a relative new comer to the area now complaining about the noisy environment he voluntarily moved into. Are any of the residents of the proposed retirement village which is in close proximity to stock cars and Highlands likely to complain? Undoubtedly.
