#### Submission

Currently I am an employee of Highlands Motorsport Park Ltd and have concerns with the proposed plan change 13 that could include 850 new residential dwellings and retirement village in an area directly opposite Highlands.

I personally moved to the area with my family in January from Auckland to Central Otago to work for Highlands. Part of the reason I moved was due to the high profile that highlands have within the community and NZ Motorsport.

Highlands is a significant business in the local area that attracts a large number of International and Local tourism to the area. The recent tour groups like Amway International, the NZ irrigation conference and the NZ Black Sticks, that all spent time at our facilities helped contribute revenue into our local area and help bring more people back due to their great experience, eating and playing at Highlands in the beautiful Central Otago environment.

Highlands employs between 25-30 people, which makes it a significant small business adding value of employment and using local services and suppliers which benefits the local economy.

Highlands also are a large contributor to the community through their sponsorships and community minded programmes. For example Central Youth Drivers, Easter Rabbit Hunt and Winter Driving programmes to keep us safe on the road.

At present there is extensive noise control monitoring in place for the existing residental surroundings. Closer higher density subdivision is very likely to cause an increased level of complaints, although a no complaints covenant has been tendered. This is likely to initiate an extremely high compliance cost.

Highlands are considered to be a world class facility and have future development aspirations which may be affected by possible local high density low cost housing.

Under this Plan change request, the location of a new residental subdivision in this area appears to be against the flow of other activities in this area. The industrial development appears to growing out towards the Highlands area from Cromwell. This is probably a better mix with Highlands activities than proposed residential subdivision.
