PUBLIC NOTICE OF DECISION ON PLAN CHANGE 18 TO THE CENTRAL OTAGO DISTRICT PLAN

Pursuant to Clause 10 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 the Central Otago District Council has accepted the recommended decision by Independent Commissioner Gary Rae on Plan Change 18 to the Central Otago District Plan and on matters raised in submissions and further submissions. Plan Change 18 proposes to re-zone land from rural to industrial in the Central Otago District Plan as detailed below:

- 1. An extension to the industrial area of Cromwell over an additional 52 hectares of Council owned land described as Lots 3-4 DP 526140 and Section 2 SO 526035 as contained in OT 894762 between Bannockburn Road and Cemetery Road, north of the Department of Conservation ("DoC") managed Cromwell Chafer Beetle Nature Reserve, and east of the Highlands Motorsport Park and Speedway land; and
- 2. Addition of approximately 11 hectares of land described as Lots 1 2 DP 390710 owned by Cerise Orchard) and two areas from Lot 3 DP 505292 (2.376ha and 1547m₂) fronting onto SH6 between the intersections of Cemetery Road and McNulty Road, connecting with the existing industrial land on McNulty Road.
