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Hi

Many thanks for the email. Unfortunately due to illness I was unable to respond formally last week.

Transpower has had a number of discussion with Council staff in regards to the Section 42A report, including the introduction of a new map that seemed to indicate a possible internal roading layout. This was the first that Transpower were aware of a potential internal roading layout and unfortunately not something that Transpower could support given the limited space between the tower and the boundary line. Transpower also notes that there is existing access over the land (on both sides of the legal boundaries) that provided for the necessary access to the tower and National Grid line. Given the circumstances Transpower would not be supportive of any activity or works, including bunding, that would impede on the National Grid.

Transpower no longer wishes to be heard at the hearing. However if the Hearing panel wish to ask any questions or have Transpower available we could make ourselves available by phone or online as necessary.

The image below shows that location of the transmission line and the existing access from our GIS system.
