Thanks for the discussion on the process for PC18 last week – it has been good to work through the transport assessment and modelling with Abley to get a clear idea of the potential effects of the proposal. As discussed I have attached a Letter which updates the Waka Kotahi position following the transportation assessment discussions with Abley and Beca. On the basis of where we have got to with these discussions it is clear that there are only marginal impacts of the proposal, even at full development, on the operation of the transport network, therefore it is not considered there is a need for Waka Kotahi to attend the hearing.

Also thanks for pointing me in the direction of the s42A report. It appears that we may not have been notified of the release of the report with neither Julie or myself receiving an email.
