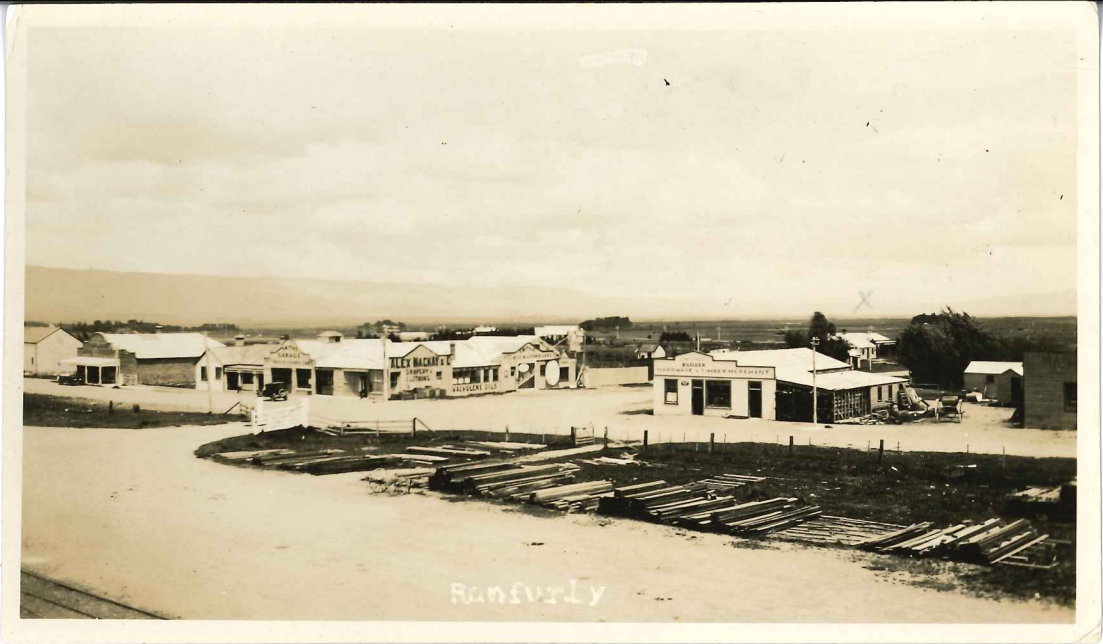
Flat Stream, Otago Central Railway, No.5. The name N. Mulholland is written on the back of the photo. (n.d.)

Butchery is W Pringles Butchery, Ranfurly. (n.d.)



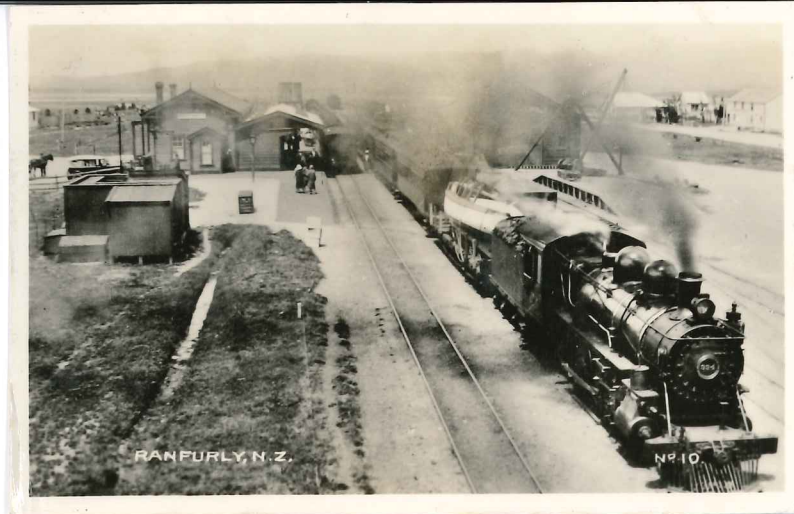
Hand written on reverse, " The other half of the main street across the railway yard from the bank. The house I have my eye on marked X." (n.d.)

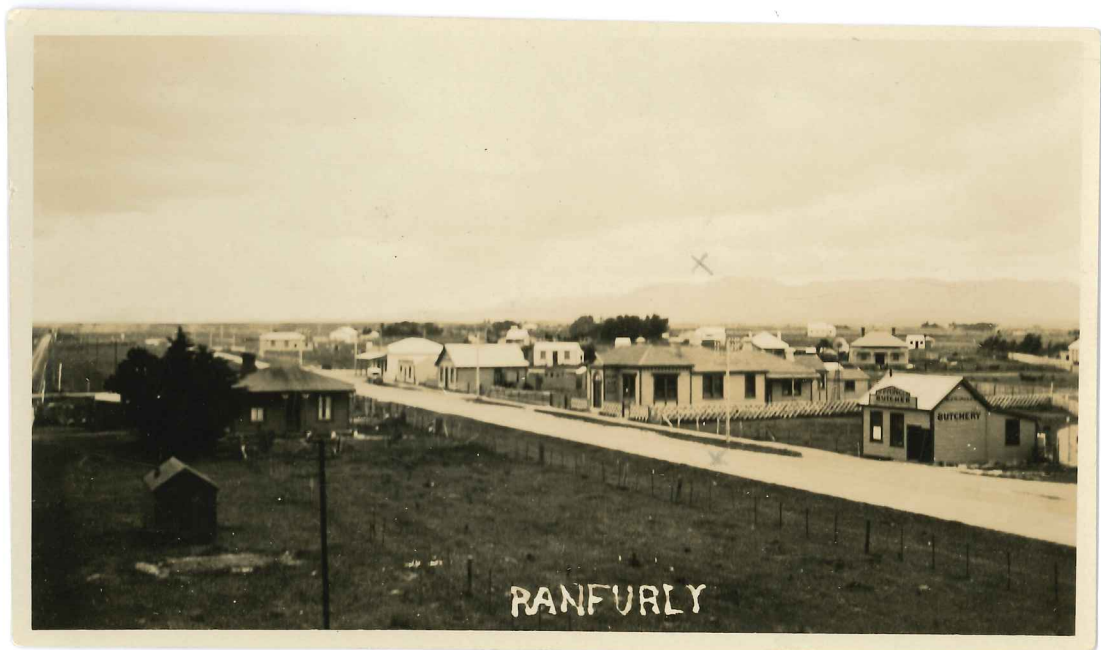
Hand written on reverse, "Donald's where I am staying and J Browns opposite where I got these Post cards which he took." (n.d.)
