I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, and in reply have to advise you that the charge represents your Council's share of the cost of the District Valuer's time and expenses incurred ~~incurred~~ while making the re-valuation. The charge also includes a proportion of the expenses of the Assessment Courts and assessors' fees, the writing of notices for issue to all owners and occupiers, writing up new Rolls, etc. In the circumstances, I am unable to see that the charge is an excessive one, and I regret, therefore, that no reduction can be made as desired.
