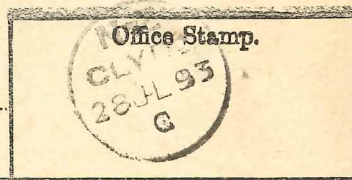
I have received

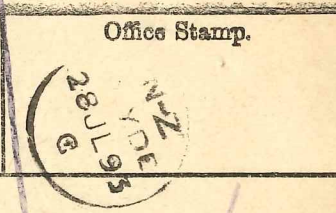

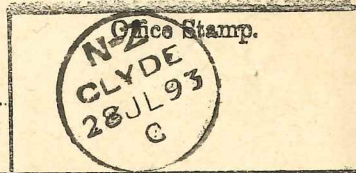
