RE AMUSEMENTS TAX: REGISTRATION OF ENTERTAINMENTS TO BE HELD IN
..ATHENAEUM HALL.....

I forward herewith a copy of the Regulations issued under the Finance Act, 1917 re Amusements Tax, and would draw your special attention to Regulations numbered 3(4) and 8.

I would suggest that, when application is made to you for permission to hold any entertainment in the above theatre hall, you satisfy yourself as to whether the entertainment in question has been duly registered or not. If it has been registered the Proprietor or Manager should produce to you a certificate issued by this Department.

If the Proprietor or Manager cannot satisfy you that his entertainment has been registered you should get him to fill up the form of Application and to forward same to this office. For this purpose I enclose herewith a supply of forms of Application for Registration. A further supply of these forms can be obtained, when required, from me.

Under the Finance Act, 1917 the word "Proprietor" means any person responsible for the management of an entertainment.
