After considering the road question, I have come to the following conclusion

1. at the loss of about 50 acres of land @ 2/6 per ac per yr =	£6-5
Then 18 year lease	£112-10
Lifting fence & putting down same	50-0
Providing water supply equal to present supply	£100-0
Total	£292-10
