Referring to your letter of the 17<sup>th</sup> inst I beg  
to inform you that it appears I was mistaken when  
I said the Government would pay rates in respect  
to the land taken out of Run No 210 for defence purposes.  
The rates have quite correctly been collected from the

roll as pointed out in my letter of the 15<sup>th</sup> Dec. Your  
demand for rates for 1883, 4 has been sent on to the  
Treasury for payment, first having amended it by  
striking out the land above referred to, and Sec 24 O'Ballans  
Riding, which is a school site and exempt, and if you  
will now make your demand for 1882, 3, also omitting  
them, I will send it on also. — Yours enclosed

I have only just been able to procure the information necessary to enable me to reply to your letter of the 16<sup>th</sup> ultimo on the subject of the 8000 acres taken from Run 210 and sold under deferred payments, and I now beg to inform you that the land will be found on the supplementary Roll of Crown lands to be supplied to the County upon which the Government will pay rates for 1882-3: for 1883-4 you will have to cover the Roll as provided by Section 10 of the Rating Act 1882 by placing on it the names of the purchasers. It will now be necessary for you to alter the Roll with respect to this best Ireland & Australia land Co by reducing the area of Run 210 and making a proportionate reduction in the value.
