At a first meeting of the Naseby Municipal ^{Council} holden
in the Victoria Hall Naseby on Thursday the 3rd
day of April 1873

Present

The Mayor - Councillors Busch Brookes Wilson
Hae de launton and Brown

The acting Town Clerk produced the returns of the
Officers constituting this Council

The Officer of Town Clerk was then entertained when the
acting Town Clerk retired during the discussion

The acting Town Clerk was called into the room when
the question of Valuators was discussed

Proposed by Councillor de launton seconded by Councillor
Brookes and carried

Town Clerk

That the office of Town Clerk Collector for the
Naseby Corporation be combined and that the payment
for such services shall be for the first year not less than
at the rate of Fifty pounds with an allowance
additional of ten per cent for collections of Rates and
Minor Taxes

Valuators

Moved by Councillor Busch 2nd by Counc^r Wilson 1st

2 That Mess^{rs} Walter Under and John Morrison be
appointed as Valuators to assess all property liable
to rates in this Municipality and that their fees
shall be £3.3.0 each for their services

Amendment by C de launton 2nd by C^r Brookes & carried

3 That the appointment of Valuators be postponed until
it can be ascertained who will accept the Offices

The Office of Inspector of Nuisances was then
discussed

Inspector of Nuisances Moved by Councillor Busch 2nd by Councillor Hae

4 That Police Constable Gray be appointed Inspector
of Nuisances for this Municipality with the consent of
the Commissioner of Police at a salary of five pounds
per Annum - (withdrawn)

Moved by Counc^r Wilson 2nd by Counc^r Brown and carried
5 That the Clerk be instructed to ask the Police Officer
in charge to recommend a certain Constable to the
Commissioner for the appointment of Inspector of
Nuisances for Municipality of Town of Kaslo

Moved by Councillor Brown 2nd by Counc^r Wilson and carried
6 That the salary of the Inspector of nuisances be Five
pounds per annum

Moved by Counc^r de Lantou seconded by J. Brooks & carried
Finance Committee
7 That the following Members of this Council constitute
the Finance Committee namely Councillors Brown
Busch & Wilson

Moved by Councillor Brown 2nd by Counc^r Hore & carried
General purposes
8 That the following Members of this Council constitute
the General purposes Committee namely Councillors

Moved by Councillor Busch 2nd by Councillor Brooks & carried

9 That the following members of this Council constitute
the Sanitary Committee namely Councillors de Lantou
Brown and Hore

Moved by Councillor de Lantou 2nd by Counc^r Busch & carried

10 That this Council hold fortnightly meetings on Tuesdays
The first meeting to be held on Tuesday the 8th instant
at the hour of 4 o'clock in the afternoon and each
subsequent meeting at the same time

Moved by Councillor Busch 2nd by Counc^r Wilson & carried
Advertisement for Down Kern
11 That the Acting Town Clerk be instructed to advertise
in the Mount Ida Chronicle for a person willing to fulfil
the the office of Down Kern and collector of Rates - the
office of Down Kern at not less than at the rate of £50 per
annum and ten pounds per centum per annum for
collections for Rates and Minor Taxes applications to be
sent in to the Mayor on or before Tuesday the 8th instant
at 3 p.m.
