I have the honor by direction of the Chairman to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17<sup>th</sup> inst. requesting to be informed of the amount of Salaries paid to the Officers of this Council, allowances for travelling, and also the rates paid to day labourers,

In reply I have to inform you that the Clerk and Treasurer to the Council, and the Inspector of Works, receive Salaries at the rate of £250 each per annum, without any travelling allowances, and the rate of wages paid to day labourers in the employment of the Council is seven Shillings per day,

The Chairman will be much obliged if you will furnish similar information from your County.
