Sir,

I have to intimate that a  
Correspondence has been going on between  
this office and Mr. James Holt, with regard to  
the road between the area leased to him  
in Block 2 Learning Rock District and the main  
road between Clyde and Cromwell being recorded  
on official plans. - Mr. Holt has been  
informed that the road has been put on the  
plans, and as the sectional survey along the  
said road is proceeded with, the exact position  
of the road will be filled in - but being  
dissatisfied with this, he again applied to  
the Board through his agent Mr. Simpson to  
have the road surveyed, and a resolution

was

was adopted by the Board requesting the Chief Surveyor to lay off the same, but as this cannot be done without special instructions from the Surveyor General, he declined to proceed with the survey -

The matter was therefore again considered by the Board at a meeting of the 4<sup>th</sup> inst when it was resolved "that as a survey cannot be made by the Government, unless paid for, the Board would suggest that under the circumstances, the County Council might make the survey"
