for the work, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Form of
Agreement sent (in duplicate) herewith.

I HEREBY undertake, on behalf of the Vincent County
Council that the sum of £ 300 : 0 : 0 voted

by Parliament (being part of Vote 113)

Item 300, for Construction of punt

across the Hawea River Lower Hawea & Lower Manakau

and proposed to be paid to the County Fund Account, under the

9th section of "The Immigration and Public Works Appropriation Act,

1894", shall be expended solely on the above-named work, upon the terms and conditions following:—

(1.) That the money shall be placed at the credit of the County Fund Account in such sums and at such times as may be necessary for the payment of works in progress or completed.

(2.) That, before any progress-payment is thus made a certificate under the hand of the Engineer, or other officer in charge of the work, shall be sent to the Chief Surveyor of the district for transmission to the Surveyor-General, certifying that the sums already issued have been duly expended on the work, and that the work is being satisfactorily carried on; and that a similar certificate shall be sent on the completion of the whole work.

(3.) That all claims for compensation for any lands taken or damage sustained in the carrying-out of the said work be paid by the County Council out of its own funds, and that none of the amount above stated shall be used for the purpose of such compensation.

(4.) That, in the event of its being proved to the satisfaction of the Minister that any part of the said moneys has been expended for any other purpose than that stated above, such part may be deducted from any subsidies or other moneys thereafter payable to the Council by the Government.

(5.) That the plans and specifications are approved by the Chief Surveyor Dunedin and payment made on his certificate that the work has been satisfactorily performed.

6 that the County out of its own funds shall provide any further sum required to place the punt.
