Sir

I shall be obliged if you will cause to be furnished a report on the works you have undertaken by authority of the Minister of Lands to open Crownlands for sale up to 30<sup>th</sup> June next.

The report should include all work done to that date since 30<sup>th</sup> June 1886 and should state briefly what has been done, and the Crownlands which have been beneficially affected, with a view to publication for the information of Parliament.

Tracings or maps are generally very useful in illustration of the text.

It should be dispatched here not later than 1<sup>st</sup> July but earlier if you can anticipate the results for a short period, as Parliament may not sit so late as usual.
