In reply to a letter from the Bounty Engineer, dated the 16<sup>th</sup> inst. - The plans showing upon what roads it is intended to expend the sum of £101 11/- accrued during period 30<sup>th</sup> Jan'y to 29<sup>th</sup> July 1893, stated by the Engineer to have been posted on the 12<sup>th</sup> July last, have not come to hand.
