

Cyde 19th November 1890

Sir

I have to send the receipt of yours of
yesterday date re transfer of the Borough
of Cyde within the County of Vincent
and in reply to inform you that the
whole matter was settled under the
provisions of Part XIV. of the Municipal
Corporation Act of 1875.

There was a Mutual
agreement between the Borough Corporation and
the County Council that certain reserves were
made (Public buildings &c.) and placed under a
"trust" irrevocable to the local body and
whose sole duty and interest consisted in
the conduct of the public library. Transferred &c.
The Borough was at the time of transfer free
from debt, the principal item £5,000 (bridge
over the Clifton River) having been paid by and
taken over by the Government and vested in
the County Council.
