Please state as clearly as possible the extent of the road you would recommend to be formed; the nature of the work to be effected; the cost per chain as well as the total cost of each road you recommend. Also state what area of unsold land will be benefitted by the roads being formed. In every case if possible send a plan showing the road proposed to be formed with the nature of the proposed formation shown on it.

Any plan you may require or send in I will return you a clean duplicate.

Please give this your earliest attention as the matter is urgent.

I have the honour to request that you will forward to this office at your earliest convenience a Report on the Roads formed to give access to unsold lands within your country for the year ending 31st March 1895. Please give a separate report on each road on which there has been a Government Grant. State the exact distance of road formed by the money granted and give full particulars of the nature of the works carried out. Give the approximate area of brown Lands opened or to which improved means of access have thereby been given.

A map on any convenient scale would help to illustrate your report. Please mark thereon the position with full particulars of the works effected during the past year. I will return you clean duplicates of any lithographs you may send in or furnish you with any you may require.

The above information will be included in my Annual Report to the Surveyor General which I have been requested to forward to the Head Office before the end of March. I shall therefore esteem it a favour if you can let me have your report as soon as possible.
