MEMORANDUM.

THE SURVEY OFFICE,

DUNEDIN, N.Z.

January 8th 1886.



To the Chairman of the
Vincent County Council
Clyde.

For your information of the County Council
I beg to inform you that by the direction
of the Surveyor General Mr Surveyor
Mihnot ran the boundary line between the
Counties of Lakes & Vincent for the purpose of
determining which County the Criffel
diggings were in, with the result that he
found the said diggings situated in the first
named County. The line has been marked on the ground
E. W. Adams Chief Surveyor
