

## **Vincent County Council – 1878-1881**

### **File A3 – Correspondence – Water Races**

- Brief report from County Engineer, Macgeorge, after inspection of the Carrick Water Race – 21 March c.1881
- Application letter from Cameron & Hansen – to construct water race and a tailrace for mining purposes. Water race will cross the Ida Valley road – 23 March 1881
- Telegraph to Vincent Pyke from Jackson Keddell informing him that the Cameron and Hansen application for water and tail race had been granted – 29 March 1881
- Correspondence between the Vincent County Council Clerk, Engineer and Messrs Cameron and Hansen re application for a water race out of Chatto Creek and across Black Road – 13 March to 21 April 1880
- Letter of complaint re condition of road due to pipe laying – 26 August 1879
- Correspondence re application from Richard Holden to construct a culvert or open water table across a county road in correspondence with the application to the Warden for the Dunstan District by Hansen to construct a head race from Cooper's Creek to a point near Cox's gully – 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> March 1878
- Application from H Campbell and JA Whelan of Wanaka to construct a water race commencing on east side of river Hawea about 2 ½ miles above junction with River Clutha and terminating a River Clutha below McPherson's Punt – 10 September 1878
