

Report on Contracts

Contract No. 1

Muddy Creek to Lander Creek.

This work has been finished for some time but has not been passed. The latter portion of the work has been executed in a most shameful manner. The specifications provide that 12 inches of stone stone shall first be spread with bunches of gravel on the top. In the last 45 chains the stone has been omitted except in patches, which are not worth while taking notice of, and I would therefore recommend that a reduction of £3 per chain or £135 be made from the contract amount. Unfortunately I was not on the road while this was going on, with the exception of one occasion (and then the pitting was on) being busy with the plans of the bridges at that particular time.

Contract No. 3

Dam, flood channel crossing Ophir.

This work is approaching completion and should be finished in a week or ten days from now. It is a very good piece of work and reflects credit on the Contractors (Capts. Brown and Bruce).

Contracts 11 & 12

Road at Oscar Goss Flat.

This has now been finished for some time. The gravel is binding well and is making a good road.

Contract 15 Road past Thompson's farm Ida Valley
 Nothing more has been done to this work
 since my last report the water in the
 Poolburn creek being still too high. The
 contractor (Thompson) has applied for a further
 extension of time and I would recommend
 that the request be granted the extension to
 be for one month.

Contract 21 Construction of bridge over Celutha river.

The contractor has been engaged in getting
 the piles and other timber necessary. Some of the
 timber is now on the ground and a start is
 to be made tomorrow in the driving of staying
 piles. It is my intention when a fair start
 is made, to station Mr. Gary the Inspector
 permanently on the works it being absolutely
 necessary that some person shall be on the
 ground to pass timber and otherwise overlook
 the work.

Contract 22 continuation of Haudy creek contract.

This work will soon be finished. It is
 in accordance with the ^{terms of} specifications with
 the exception of some unimportant particulars
 which I have directed to be put right.

Contract 23 Graving, kerbing & channelling Main street Ophir.

A good deal of the stone required for the
 kerbing has been quarried but a start has
 not yet been made at the formation.

I have written to the contractor, instructing

him to commence at once.

Contract 24 Graveling at Bald Hill Flat.

About 15 chains of this graveling is finished and the work is satisfactory. The contractor has applied for 3 weeks extension of time and his letter explaining is attached. I would recommend that the application be granted.
