- Note from the Hon. Mr Olion? asking to be informed amounts paid out of vote for aid to flood districts in Otago and what remains unpaid. Attached is the information requested – November 1879
- Telegraph from the Secretary Treasurer requesting remittance of £432-4-8p at once – February 1878
- Letter from the John Knowles, Public Works Office regarding the advance to be made to the Vincent County Council to aid in repairing damage by the late floods – 4 November 1878
- Letter from the Minister of Lands acknowledging receipt of communication from members of Committees appointed at public meetings held at Cromwell, Bannockburn and Bendigo praying that action will be taken to carry out the provisions of Sec 119 of the Land Act 1877 with regard to runs in the Vincent County – 22 August 1881
- Telegraph from A Atkinson saying Government decided not to withhold subsidy to repay flood advance, subsidy remitted county funds Bank New Zealand, Cromwell – 8 December 1880
- Report on the damage done to public works by the recent flood in the Clutha river – 24 October 1878
- Remaining correspondence addresses the damage caused by the 1878 floods – 1878 - 1880
