subscription.

ELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS: New members shall be proposed and seconded

MAKING RULES ETC:

New rules may be made or existing rules

MEETINGS:

times as occasion may require and may be convened either by a circular addressed to each member or by advertisment in some paper circulating in the Naseby District. Special Meetings may be convened by order of the Committee or by a requisition in writing signed by at least seven members stating the purpose for which the meeting is required.

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT: Committee of Management shall consist of President, Vice-President and Treasurer and six members of the Qub who shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Club which shall be held on the First Tuesday in August in each year.

APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS: Officers shall consist of President, Vice--President, Treasurer and Auditor and shall be appointed by a majority of the members present at the annual meeting of the members of the Club and any officer or member of committee may be removed at any meeting of the members on a resolution carried by a majority of those present. The committee of Management shall have sole control over the funds and the investment thereof.

CONTROL OF FUNDS:

EXPULSION OF MEMBERS:

observe any rule of the Club for the time being in force or shall be guilty of any misconduct which in the opinion of the majority of the members of the Club shall justify expulsion or shall be disqualified by any racing club for breach of any of the regulations or rules of racing for the time being in force;

DISSOLUTION OF THE CLUB: The Club may be dissolved upon a resolution to that effect being carried by a majority of the members present at a special meeting called for that purpose and the property of the Club shall be disposed off as such majority or any sub-committee appointed by such majority may decide.
