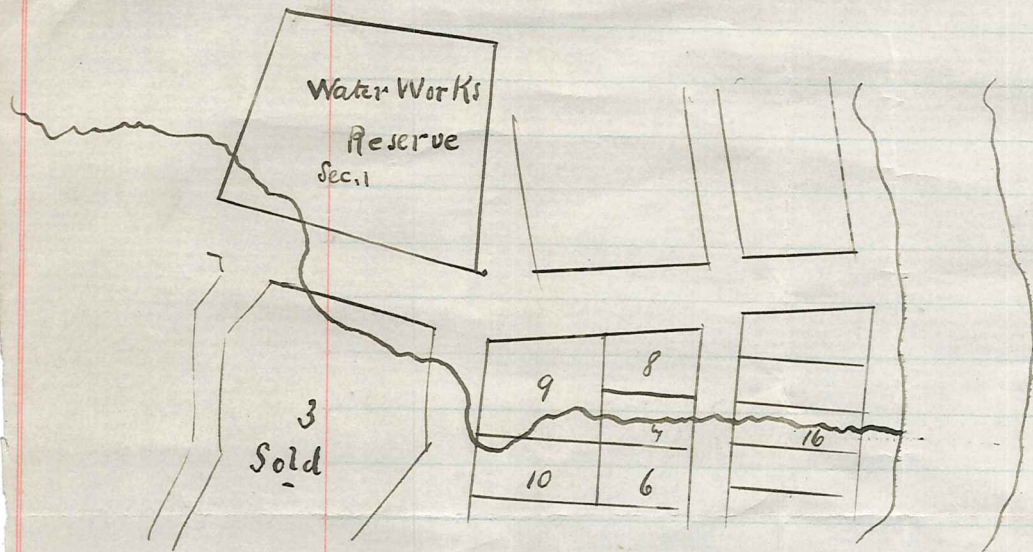


I have the honor to apply to you for directions under the following circumstances.



The Roxbury Borough Council, for which I act, being desirous of constructing proper water works, and of securing their rights legally, have intrusted me to take steps to secure the same.

Section 1 Pl. XXIV Town of Roxbury shown on the plan hereon is reserved to the Council as a site for Water-works.

Through this Section runs a Creek known as the Water-works Creek, which afterwards passes through various other Sections shown on the plan and finds its way to the Chetka River. Only one of these lower Sections has been sold, and with the owner of that one I hope to make a friendly arrangement.

But before the other Sections (Crown Lands) are sold the Council desire to have a Proclamation by the Governor taking from the owners, present or prospective, of the lower Sections (namely 9, 10, 7 and 16 Pl. XXIV Roxbury) all riparian rights and vesting the same in the Borough Council. This would give the Council absolute power to dam the water of the Creek

and take all the water therefrom; while without it the Council would always be liable to claims by the riparian owners further down the stream.

The Governor's Proclamation the Council would apply for as prescribed by Subsec. 5 of Sec. 11 of "The Public Works Act 1882" but before taking any steps to obtain the same I have the honor to request you to inform me what evidence or documents will be required by you, before you can advise His Excellency to issue such a Proclamation as prayed.

(3) The Board is not to be called on to pay any costs: that is to say, the Roxburgh Corporation must pay the costs of the Church Board's Solicitors in perusing the Transfer and Agreement.

I now enclose my drafts in order that you may see more plainly what the Agreement proposed will amount to: but of course these drafts have not yet been submitted to the Church Board or their Solicitors.

As instructed by you I duly made application to the Church Board requesting them to state for what price they would sell their water Rights in section 1 Block XXIV and pointing out that if a price could not be arranged on, the Corporation would be compelled to take the land under The Public Works Act 1882.

After some correspondence and consideration the Board consented to transfer its rights without any money consideration Provided (1) The Board are to be entitled like other ratepayers to supply of water on their Sec. 1 Block XXIV, but are not to be liable to pay any water rates therefor.

(2) What water escapes from the Dam and flows down the bed of the Creel, the Board

I have now the pleasure of advising you that the sections in Blocks XVII and XIX Town of Roxburgh, through which the Waterworks Creek runs, have been temporarily reserved for water supply purposes (N. Z. Gazette, June 16 fo. 762) and will be permanently reserved after the lapse of one month in terms of Sec. 228 Land Act 1885. This course appears to have been taken by the Crown in consequence of the opinion of the Law Officers that the Government could not take the rights of riparian owners by Proclamation under the Public Works Act.

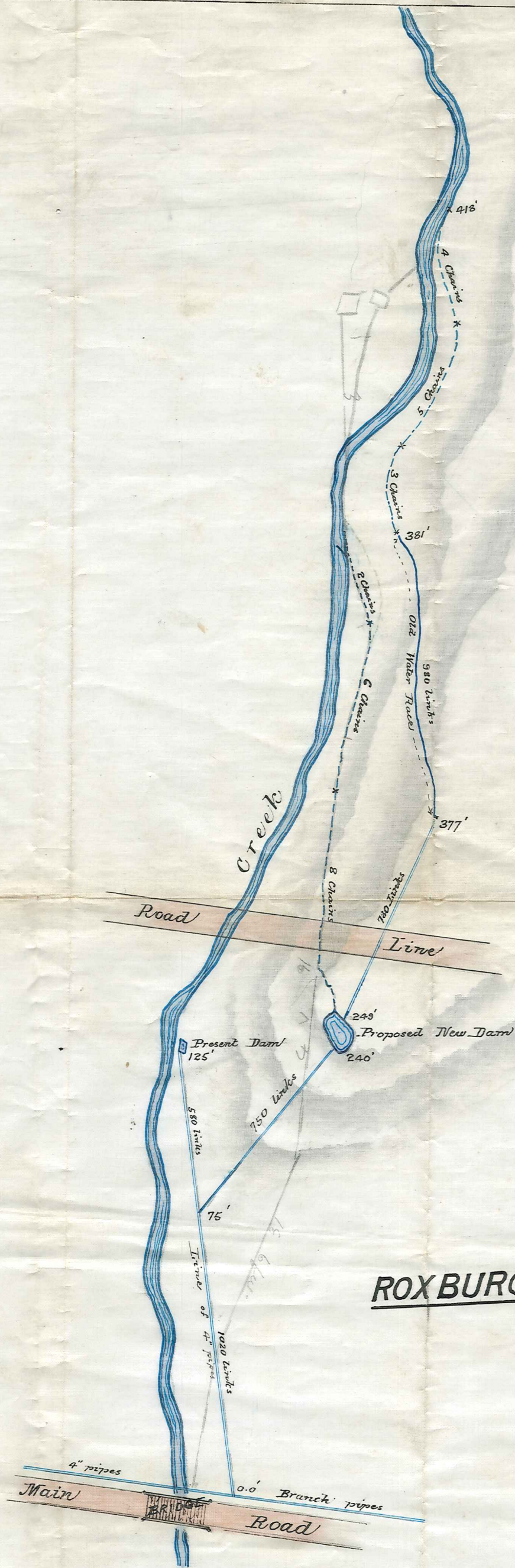
Dear Sir,

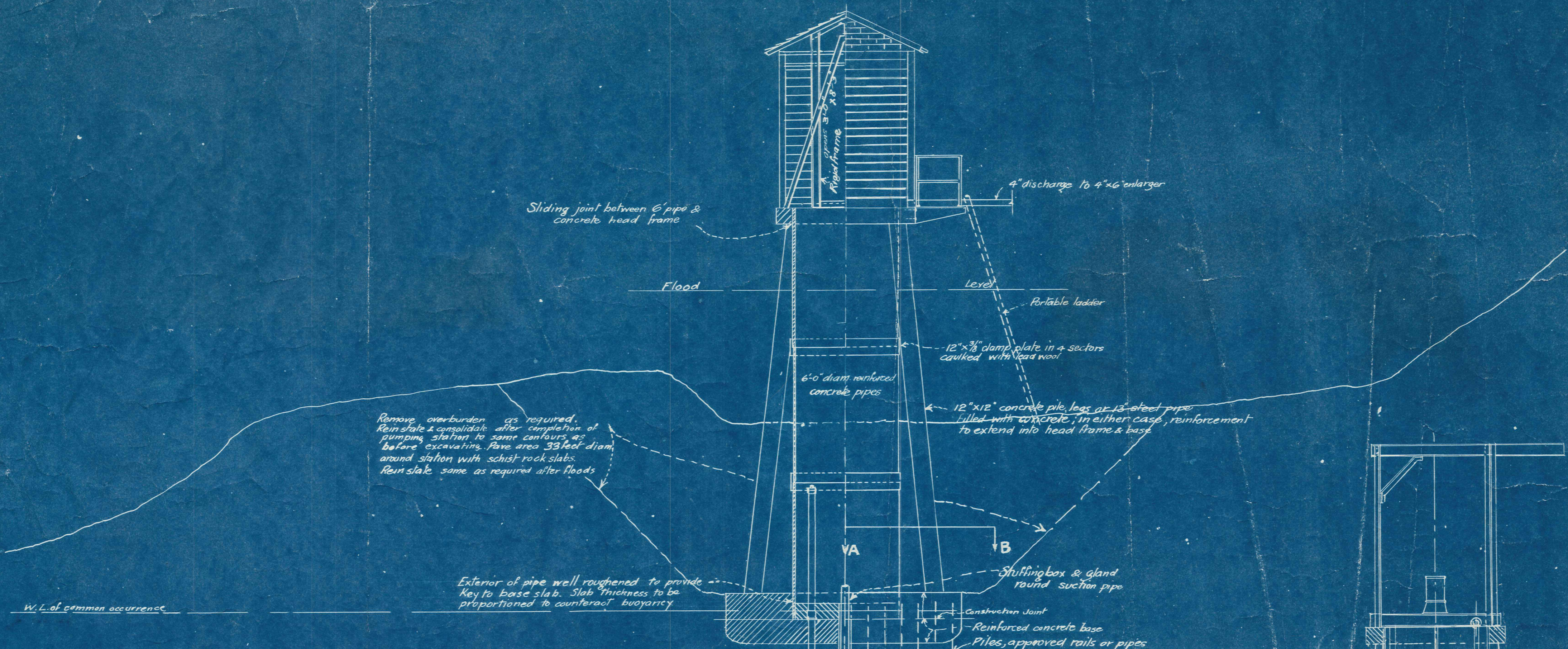

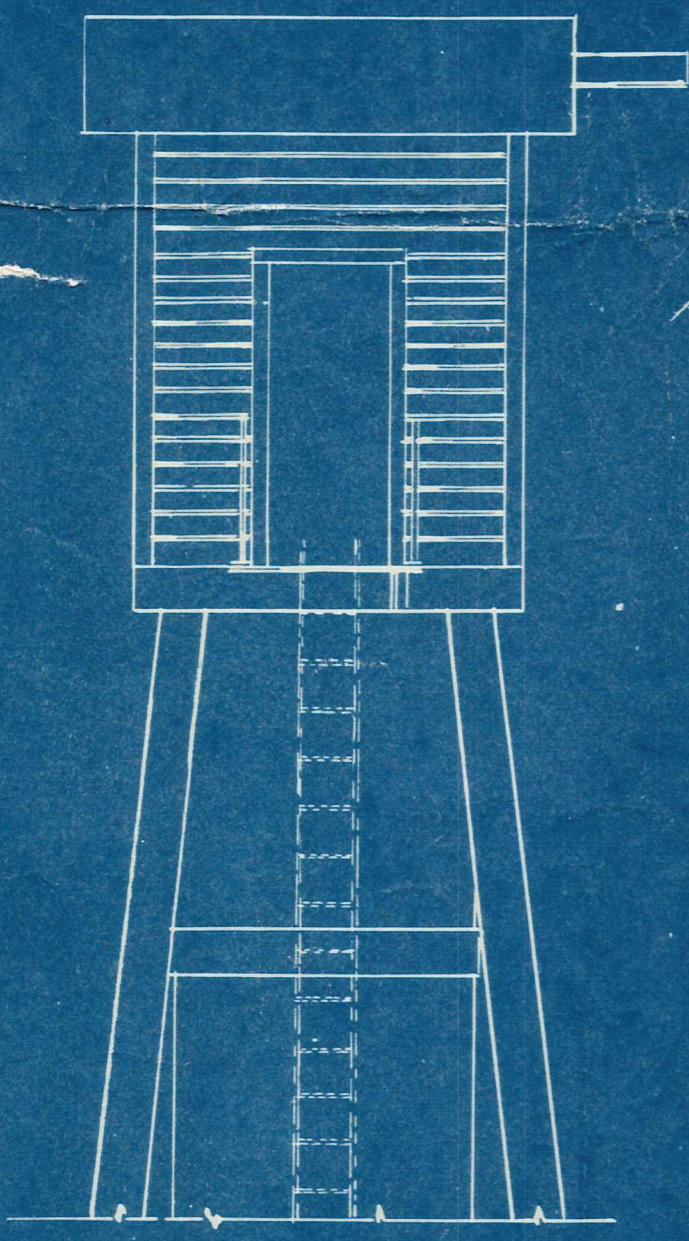

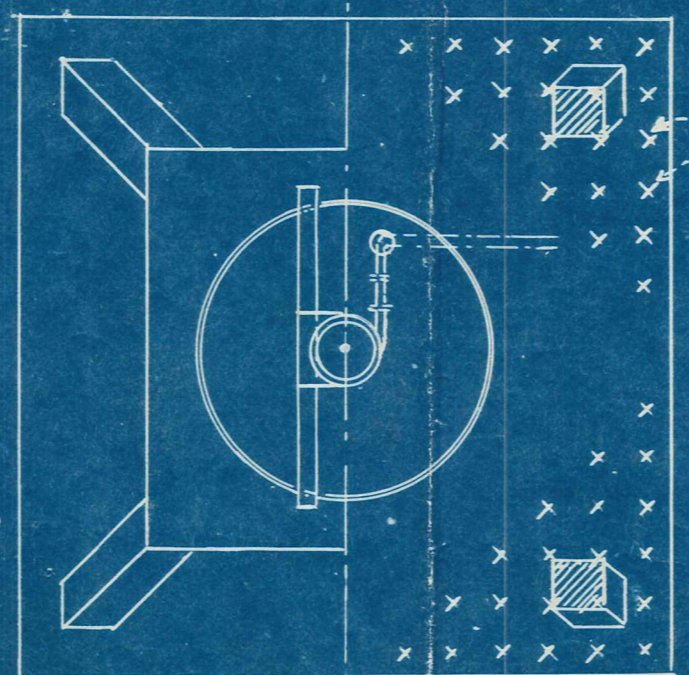

looking downstream.

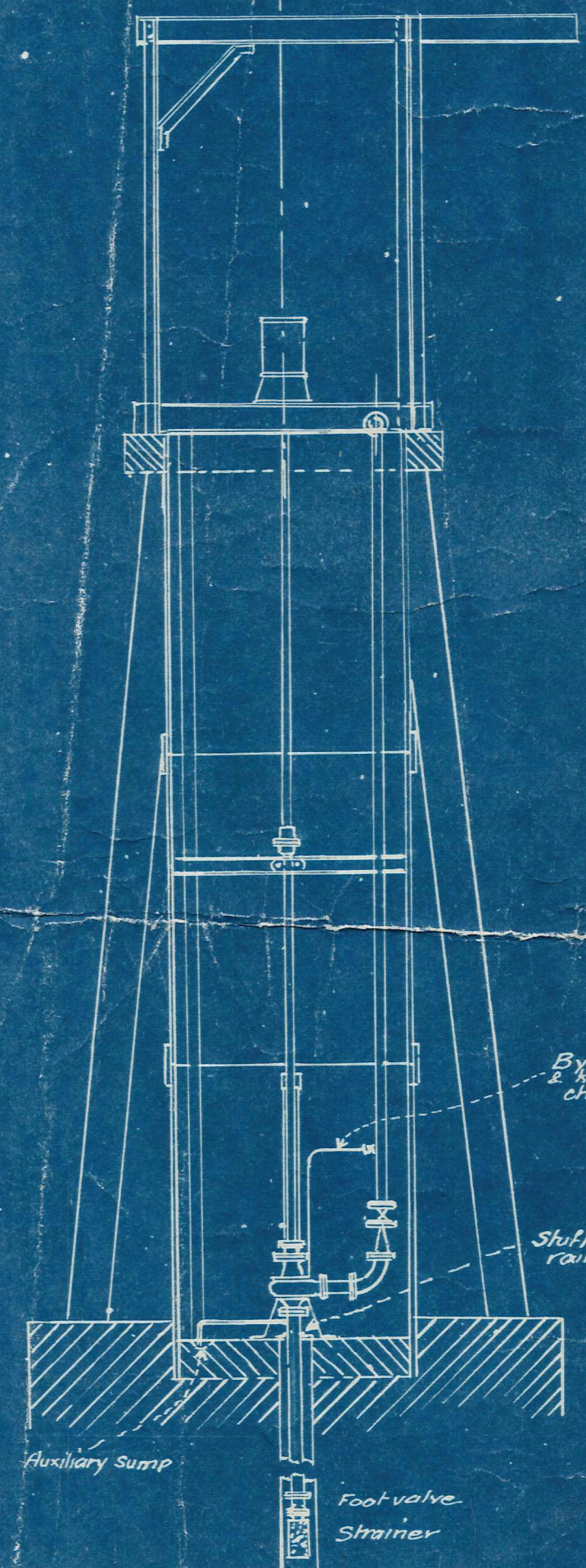


ELEVATION

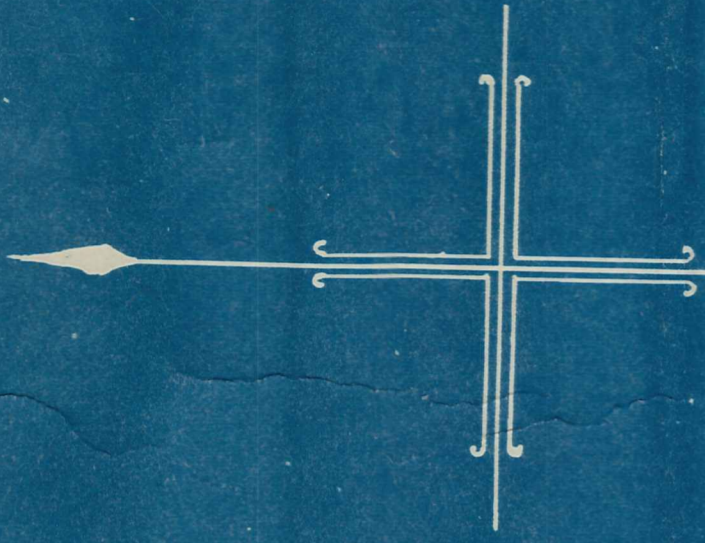
ROXBURGH WATER SUPPLY

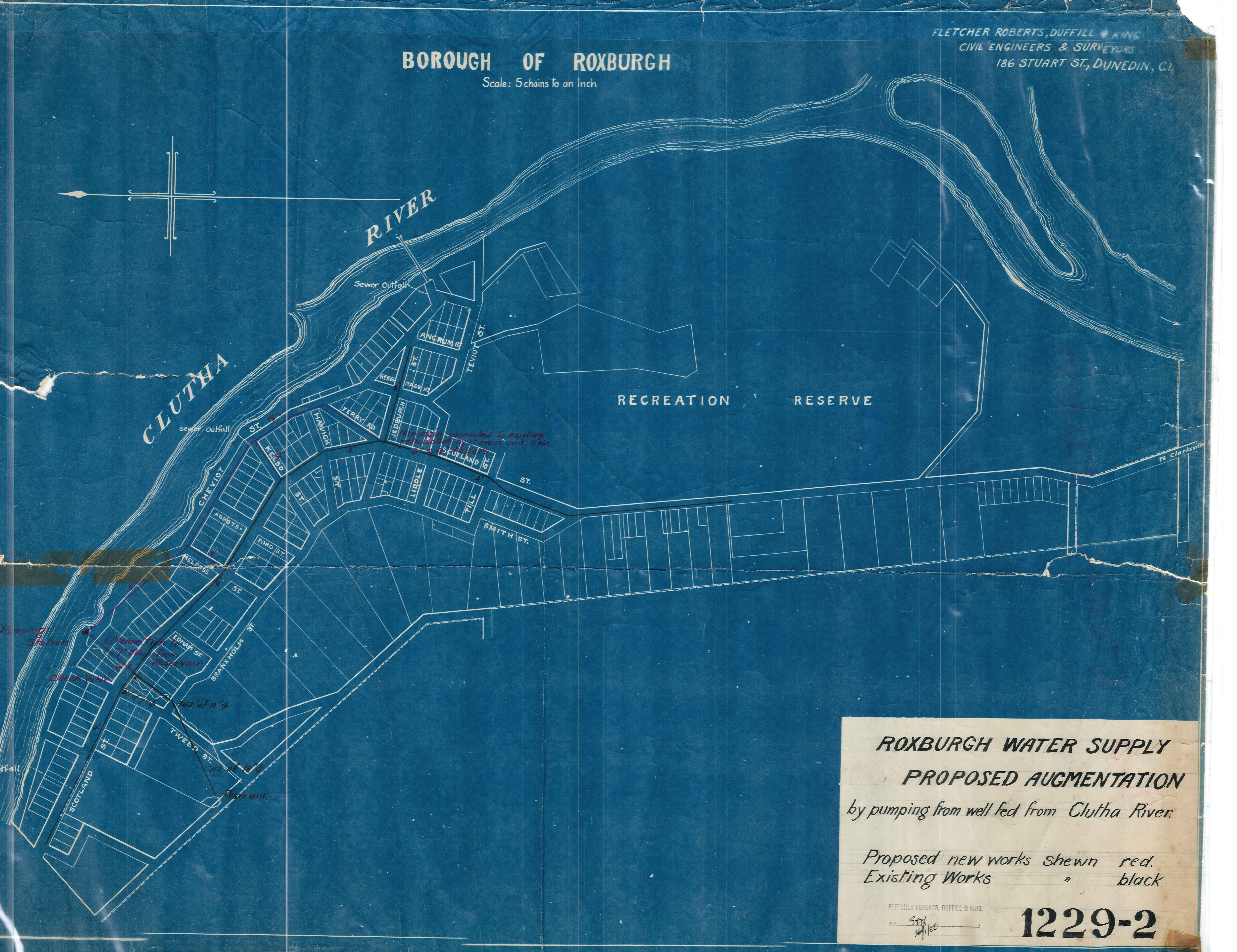

by pumping from well fed from Clutha River.

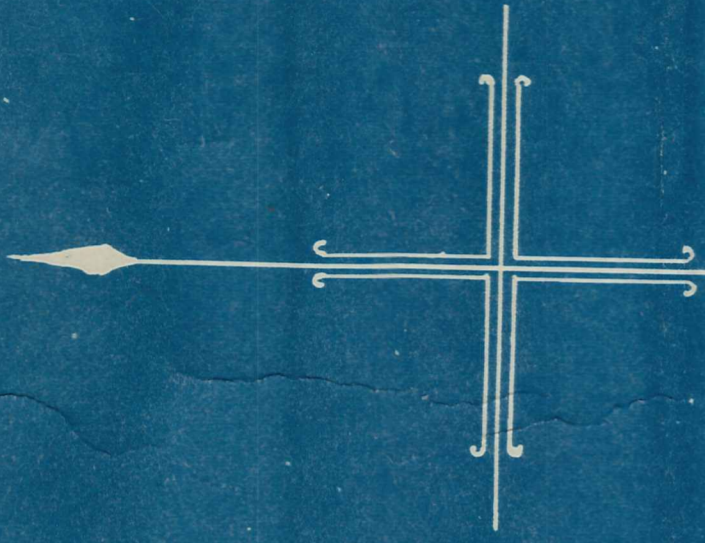

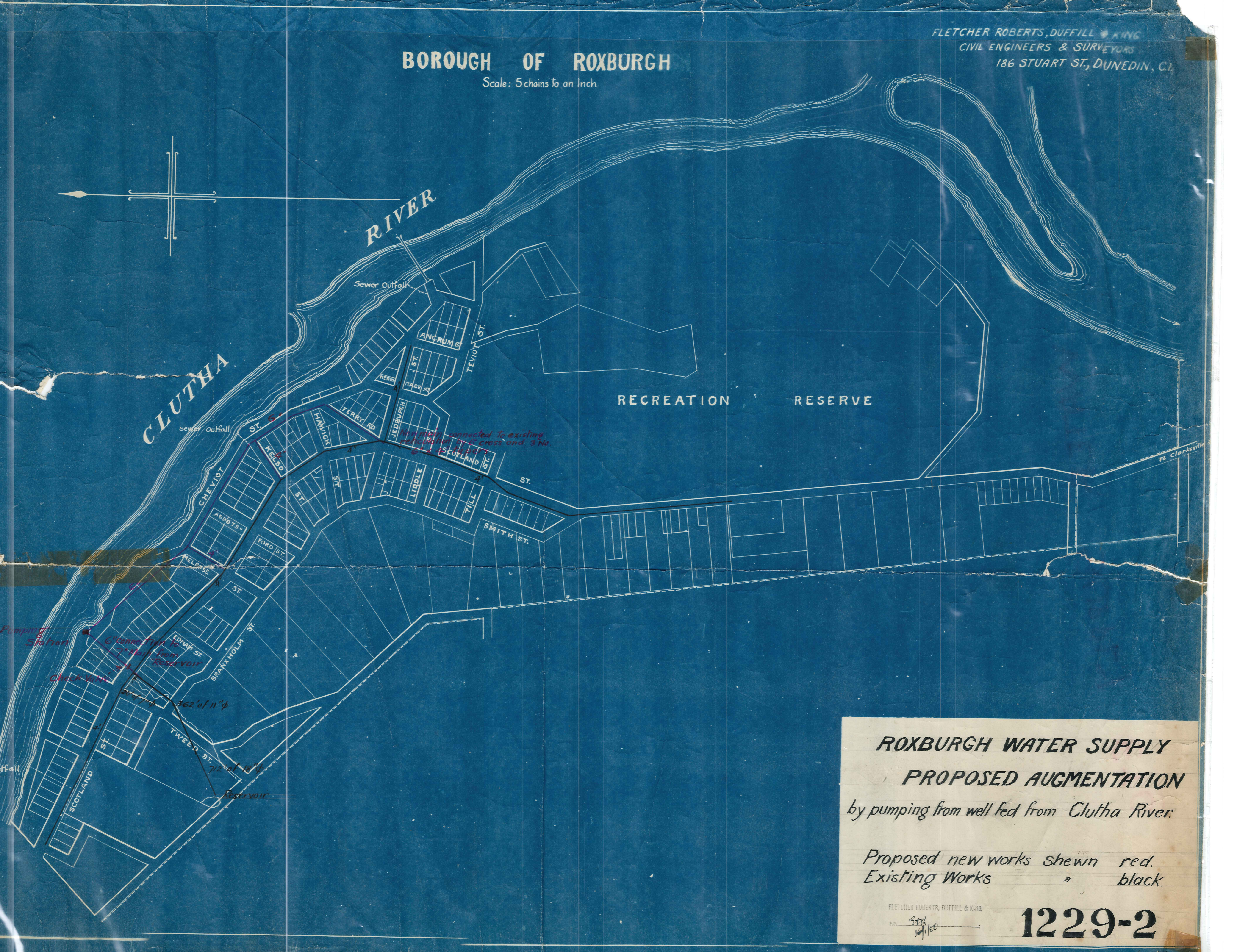

PROPOSED AUGMENTATION
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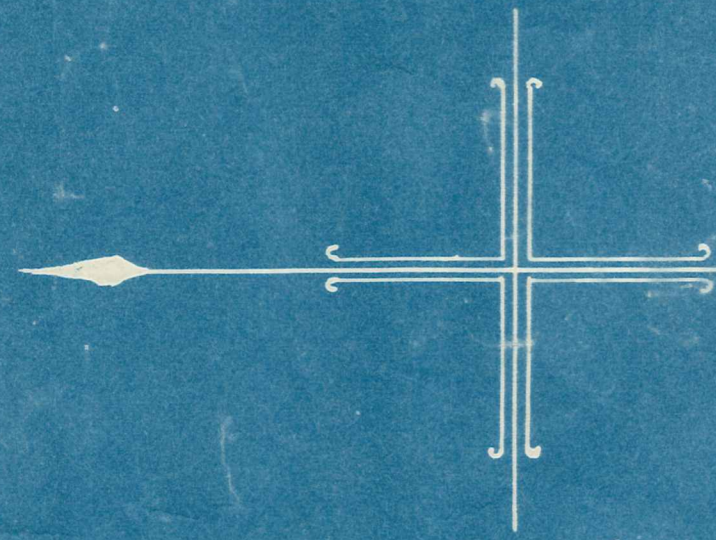

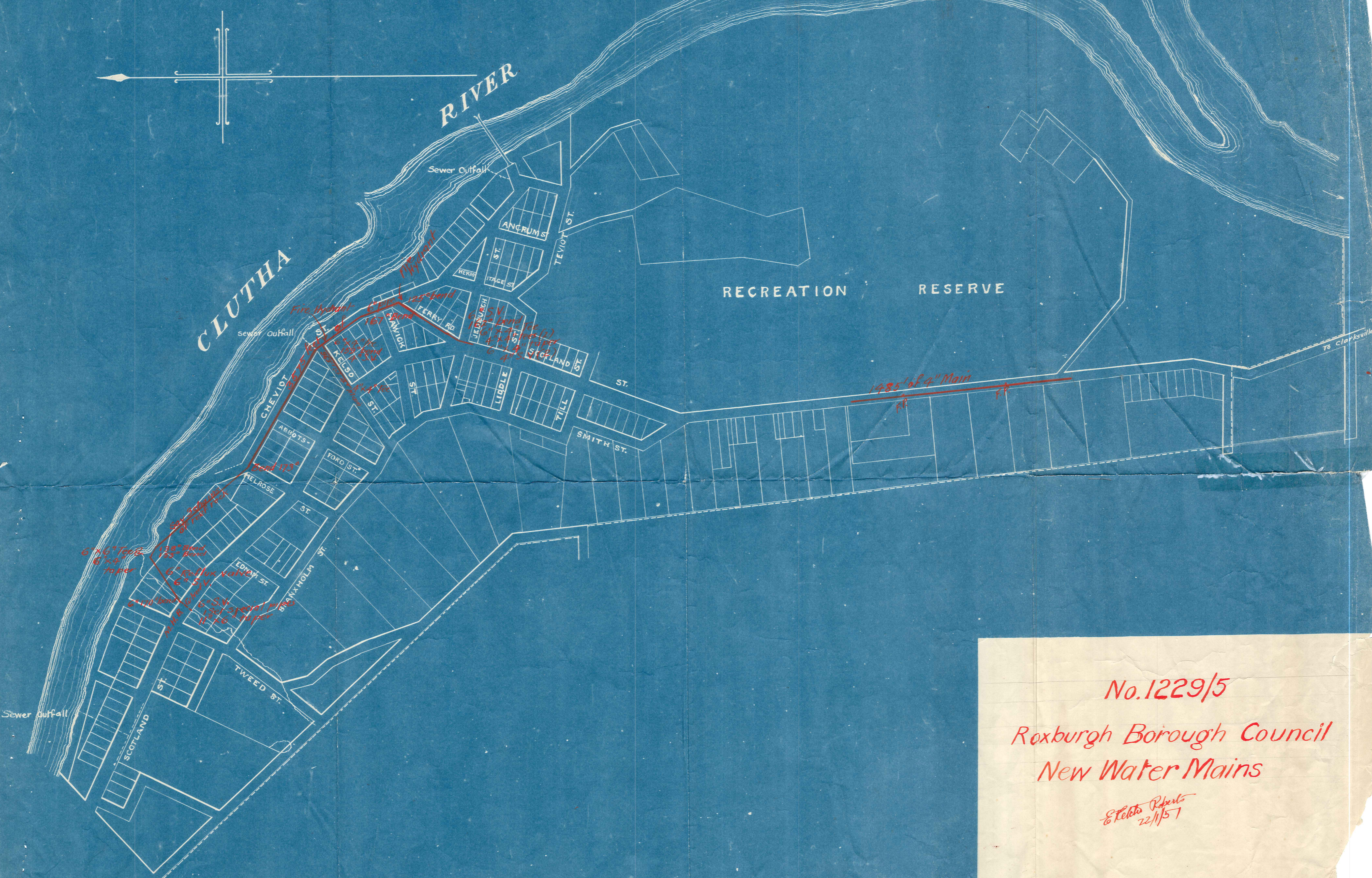
