The Memorial of the undersigned Ratepayers
humbly sheweth

1st That by the Bye Laws relating to the slaughtering
of Cattle, there is no sufficient inspection of
Stock by the Inspector of Slaughterhouses
provided for, so much so is this the case, that
anyone in possession of a Slaughtering License
may kill Cattle and Sheep other than those given
notice of, and the Inspector be nothing the wiser,
if so, it would be only by chance

2nd That we would suggest that the inspection to
be thorough, the Inspector should be compelled
to see all Cattle and Sheep before they are
slaughtered, and that Sheep should be so skinned
as to leave both ears on the skins, and that
the Inspector should inspect all skins, on
his next visit, and that the owner of a Slaughtering
License should be compelled to keep all skins
until so inspected, say once a week

We your Memorialist therefore pray that you
will take this our Memorial into your serious
consideration, and give effect to the same.
