I am in receipt of Copy of view. Re McAndrew  
Bridges. I think the reply is more conclusive, and nothing  
could be gained by further Correspondence with Resistants  
It makes the amount voted definite viz £450 and  
the special vote of £100, see what the engineer thinks  
and if he agrees, that further Correspondence with the  
Trustees not necessary, it will be as well to call the  
Special meeting as agreed.

In my mind the only thing that might be done would be  
to get Sherrin to stand and have it made an unconditional  
vote (at least get the Trustees to promise to do so) when Parliament  
meets.

perhaps it might be as well for you to let me know the  
Engineer's opinion, before calling the meeting. I presume a week  
longer will not make much difference.
