 - b. A response to the matter raised by Mr Gardner-Hopkins and submitters on the opportunity to prevent future development on the balance lot 40 via a covenant or similar legal mechanism;
 - A response to any other pertinent matters arising from the presentation of submitter statements, including the additional comments from experts on landscape, amenity and streetscape and the comments from Ms Royce; and
 - d. Confirmation of whether the Applicant wishes to respond in any way to the evidence and statements of submitters (in particular in the context of the discussion with Mr Dicey for BRDI at the hearing on the relative effects of individual allotments), in terms of any possible reduction in allotment numbers and/or change in locations?
