Supplementary Document relating to the specific parts of the application (RC 240186) and my submission

Background

- My land is surrounded by two streams, the one on the south side flows through the entire west/east of the land and the other northern side in part.

What developments occur in the catchment in this application for subdivision affects both the flow and the sedimentation carried by both streams.

- It must be pointed out that these streams are not **ephemeral** as suggested (due to lack of vertebrates seen in them) they both flow all year through mine and the adjoining property (DP454158) and both originate from the land owned by Enfield Ltd.

The proposed Dam development by Enfield Ltd. currently being considered through the Otago Regional Council also potentially impacts these streams.

- I monitor the south stream several times a week as the QE11 representative (Rob Wardle) was concerned about the level of sediment in it.

For some unknown to me reason both the flow and the sedimentation has increased recently.

Comment:

The southern stream flows through to my neighbours and their pond has silted up completely twice in the last few years.

Basis for concern

That the land clearance and the building site development for both the proposed lots 7 and 8 would impact these streams.

The silting prevents vertebrates from living in them.

One (on the northern boundary) has been known to contain in the past Clutha flathead galaxias (*Galaxias* "Species D").

I do not know if they are also in both.

I note that mitigation planting is proposed but have not read anything that would prevent silt loading in these stream while the development work (building site and access road) is in progress.

What decision would improve the environmental impact?

A requirement to put in place a series of sediment traps that feed into these two valleys to prevent future sedimentation.
