

The Council Waste Transfer Stations will no longer accept cash from 1 November 2023

Secure EFTPOS payment will be available with no minimum spend or surcharge.



From 1 November 2023, Central Otago District Council Waste Transfer Stations will go cashless.

How may this affect you?

Council Waste Transfer Stations will no longer be accepting payments by cash. Payments will only be accepted by card (EFTPOS) or business account.

What facilities will be cashless?

Alexandra, Cromwell, Ranfurly and Roxburgh transfer stations.

Why have these facilities gone cashless?

Going cashless is helping us streamline our service and keep our team members and customers safe. It creates operational efficiencies, which allow resources to be focused on other Council services which benefit our community.

How will this benefit you?

- EFTPOS transactions are more convenient and faster to process, this means reduced queuing times
- Improved health and safety of customers and staff with contactless payments
- Eliminate change issues
- Reduces risk of burglary and cash theft
