I oppose the application for the solar farm for many reasons:

The chosen location is within the town and impacts the scenery and the overall look of the Maniototo. The community has put in time and effort into making the area look nice and be somewhere that visitors want to come to and I feel that the solar farm will off putting to people. There will be an impact on business from less visitors and this could impact the community with businesses shutting down due to no custom. Environmental Impacts - We have been so focused on climate change and it is so frustrating that this has been allowed to even get to this stage with the environmental risk factors - such as the disposal after it has reached end of life but also the toxins leeching into the soil, the glare, the potential for fire (and no known way to fight this) as well as things going wrong and the toxins leaking into the air and waterways.

I have concerns about house prices reducing due to this as who wants to buy near a solar farm. Insurance is likely to go up due to the risk factors of the solar batteries exploding and causing a fire.

Insurance - Risk factors are taken into account and this is

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a risk factor that we have no control over, likely to drive up the price of our premiums

Glare while driving is a concern, as there are some areas that are already known for sunstrike which is very dangerous and due to the area this solar farm covers I believe there is potential for sunstrike to occur anywhere along that stretch of road.

We have severe temperatures both hot and cold - how will the solar farm cope with the snow and ice in the winter, and then the hot hot days of summer - this is likely to affect the lifespan of the panels and potentially cause a fire.
