### **Cromwell Rising Main pipe works begin** 4 June 2024

The next stage of the \$6.4 million upgrade to Cromwell township's water supply will get underway in early June, with the installation of a 630mm diameter water pipe between the bore field on Lake Dunstan near Alpha Street and the new water treatment plant at

The work will take place between 4 June and 12 July, along State Highway 8b (SH8b) towards the Murray Terrace carpark, starting at the roundabout with State Highway 6 (SH6).

Traffic management will be in place during the pipe installation. The east-bound lane on SH8b will be closed. During this time, traffic to Cromwell town from SH6 will be detoured along Shortcut Road. People are asked to take care and follow the signage. HEB Construction Ltd is carrying out the work.

The project is expected to be completed by Spring 2024.



## **Temporary Lane Closure – Sunderland Street,** Clyde

Part of Sunderland Street in Clyde will be closed between the Naylor Street intersection to Lodge Lane from Tuesday 4 June 2024 to Friday 21 June 2024 for water toby connections and Aurora duct

The pedestrian footpath will remain open on the Southern side (Lord Clyde side).





## Winter road closures

Each winter Central Otago District Council closes several highcountry roads from the Tuesday following King's Birthday weekend (4 June 2024).

This prevents damage that would occur to these roads if they were used by vehicles during the winter months.

The following roads are legally closed under Section 342 (1)(b) of the Local Government Act 1974 and Clause 13 of the Tenth Schedule, which allow Council to temporarily close and prohibit ordinary vehicular traffic.

## **Notified Consent Public Notification**

Applicant: Grant Hensman and Ann & Robin Jones **Description of activity:** 

Grant Hensman and Ann & Robin Jones have applied for subdivision and land use consent at 29 Ritchies Road, Cromwell, legally described as Pt Sec 20 BLK IV Cromwell SD. The proposed subdivision is a discretionary activity pursuant to Rule 4.7.4 (iii) of the District Plan where the subdivision results in an average allotment size exceeding 8ha and minimum allotment size exceeding 2ha. Land use consent is sought to erect a dwelling, associated buildings and structures and undertake earthworks within the Outstanding Natural Area notation of the Rural Resource Area. The proposed dwelling and associated water storage tanks breach the performance standards of the District Plan in relation to setback from boundaries, the provision of a safe and adequate potable water supply and for earthworks for access tracks.

The application is supported by a Landscape and Visual Effects Assessment and an Assessment of Environmental Effects.

## Trees to be removed from Cromwell Greenway in

Central Otago District Council contractors will be removing a number of over-mature Pinus radiata trees from the Cromwell Greenway to the south of the Gair Ave - Jollys Road intersection from Tuesday 4 June.

The Council has received a number of requests from adjacent neighbours asking for the trees to be removed because they have become too big for the area they are in.

This section of greenway will be cordoned off while tree felling work is undertaken and is expected to take about a week to 10 days to complete the works.

The logs will be disposed of for firewood and chip from the slash used to mulch the Council's garden areas in Cromwell.

Replacement trees of a more suitable species will be replanted.
