From 1 July 2024, Central Otago District Council transfer station staff will be required to ask all customers what type of waste they will be disposing at the transfer stations.

This is a new requirement from the Ministry for the Environment (MfE) to better understand the type of waste being disposed of at transfer stations and landfills across New Zealand.

At the transfer station kiosk, please advise staff what type of activity your waste came from as per the list below:

- · Construction and demolition
- Industrial and/or commercial businesses
- · Institutional groups (including education, and sport and recreation
- Horticultural and/or farming activities
- Residential properties (excluding kerbside)

Temporary Road Closures

Cromwell

There will be several one lane closures in Cromwell town centre for the Cromwell Rising Main project over the month of July 2024. The main roads affected include Barry Avenue, Lode Lane and Murray Terrace. Detours will be in place and should not cause any significant delays to travel time.

Paerau Road, Paerau

Paerau Road Bridge in Paerau will be closed from 9am Monday 24 June 2024 to Wednesday 17 July 2024 for bridge maintenance works. The bridge will be open on the hour, every hour, throughout the day to allow traffic through. At night, the bridge will be opened with a speed restriction in place.

Millers Flat Bridge, Millers Flat

Millers Flat Bridge in Millers Flat will be closed until 5pm Friday 19 July 2024 (school holidays) for rebuilding abutments at each end of the bridge and for street light maintenance work.

A detour will be available via Jedburgh Bridge in Roxburgh. Pedestrian access over the bridge will be permitted during the daytime hours with an escort through the worksite. At night a signposted pathway will be available. No vehicles will have access during the closure.
