Neplusultra Street Reserve - public feedback on changes to management plan

Just a few days left to give feedback on two proposed tweaks to the reserve management plan for Neplusultra Street Reserve in Cromwell. Submissions close 9 June 2024.

These tweaks involve:

- Ability for Council to establish a public toilet on the reserve
- Reduce existing grassed beautification strips from 30 metres to 15 metres on street frontages.

This will enable Council to formalise structural improvements carried out by two occupiers of the reserve, the Cromwell Bike Park, and Cromwell BMX Club.




Cromwell Rising Main pipe works are underway

The next stage of the \$6.4 million upgrade to Cromwell township's water supply got underway earlier this week, for the installation of a 630mm diameter water pipe between the bore field on Lake Dunstan near Alpha Street and the new water treatment plant at

The work is taking place between 4 June and 12 July, along State Highway 8b (SH8b) towards the Murray Terrace carpark, starting at the roundabout with State Highway 6 (SH6).

Traffic management will be in place during the pipe installation. The east-bound lane on SH8b will be closed. During this time, traffic to Cromwell town from SH6 will be detoured along Shortcut Road. People are asked to take care and follow the signage. HEB Construction Ltd is carrying out the work - see map below showing the location of works and the detour. The project is expected to be completed by Spring 2024.
